One of the goals of the California Political Treasurers Association is to promote the concept of paperless filing for Campaign Disclosure statements in California at all levels.

As such, we would like to acknowledge NetFile, Inc. and their contribution to the local agency filing community, specifically County and City agencies in California.

Our members work with several of these agencies and applaud NetFile's effort in making their Agency system work within the confines of Assembly Bill 2452 which allows a local government to electronically and paperlessly file Campaign Statements in California.
